# (1) Visiting the Expo Site by Station Shuttle Bus


- Visitors to the Expo site are advised to use public transport (trains, station shuttle buses, etc.).
- Station shuttle buses run directly to the Expo site from 10 major railway station bus terminals. (A fare will be charged for the ride.)
- All station shuttle buses require advance booking, except for buses to and from Sakurajima Station. This is a comfortable way to travel to the Expo site while seated (\*1). There is also a special service that links the railways and station shuttle buses, so please take advantage of this service.
- Shuttle buses operating from Sakurajima Station will be electric buses, normally running on five-minute intervals between 8:00 and 10:00, during peak visitor hours. During this time, priority will be given to those who have paid in advance. There are also pre-booked slots available throughout the day for wheelchair and pushchair(stroller) users.



\* 1 Excludes some services to/from Osaka Station (South: Marubiru), Nakanoshima Station, and Sakurajima Station Shuttle Buses.

\* 2 Osaka Station has two locations: North= Umekita and South= Marubiru.

\* 3 The Bentencho Station Bus Terminal is used temporarily in the event of transport disruptions, etc., so there are no regular services.



#### Recommended Points for Using Station Shuttle Buses

- OYou are guaranteed a seat on the shuttle bus to the Expo site.( \* 1)
- ORailway and bus services are linked to each other.
- OStation shuttle buses depart from and arrive at Yumeshima Transportation Terminal 1. This is approximately 150 m from the West Gate, offering close and convenient access.
- OThe West Gate has more gates, allowing for smoother entry into the Expo site.


