1	How do I apply?	Access the Events organized by the general public application page from the link on the organiser's website and apply using the entry form (URL, etc.) on that page.
2	Are any fees incurred upon applying?	There are no application fees when applying. Any production or operational fees related to the creation of proposal documents or event participation will be borne by the applicant and parties involved in implementing projects.
3	Can individuals apply?	Both individuals and organizations can apply.
4	Can amateurs apply?	Both professionals and amateurs can apply.
5	What kinds of events can be held?	We look forward to applications for a variety of event categories. Examples include: Example events: Live performances, concerts, shows, performances, dances, lectures, symposiums, talk shows, forums, presentations, festivals, bon dances, parades, contests, competitions, recitals, exhibitions, fairs, screenings, live recording of broadcasts, etc. Events genres: Music, dance, traditional arts, plays, theatre, musical, cinema, video, comedy, magic, juggling, arts, traditional arts and crafts, media, live recording of broadcasts, live broadcasting, live streaming, academic contents, education, culture and everyday life, local culture, local revitalization technology, technology, sports, medicine, health
6	Can I apply in any other way besides the online entry form (by mail, in person, etc.)?	We do not accept applications in any format other than the online entry form.
7	Can I apply for multiple projects?	You can apply for multiple event plans. You can apply from the URL in the email sent automatically after completing the provisional registration form. With multiple registrations, you can submit entries for multiple kinds of events.
8	When requesting an event to be held over multiple days, is it possible to adjust the event to a shorter period if the full schedule is rejected?	Schedules can be adjusted. The details of the event and days available for use at the venue will be considered, and adjustments may be made to accept an event if it is held over a shorter period than requested.
9	Can I change the details of a project after applying?	Project details can be changed up until the application deadline at the end of December. A link used to update details is found in the email sent after completing the entry form. Please use that link to register your project again. To change the details of a project after it has been accepted, please speak with a supervisor at the Association.
10	How are events chosen?	Participants and proposals are selected through a screening by a review board made up of experts. Please check the details of the evaluation standards (theme, quality, feasibility, etc.) from Events organized by the general public application page from the link on the organiser's website.
11	When will the selection results be released? Will all applicants be informed of the selection results, whether accepted or rejected?	We expect to notify participants of the selection results no sooner than April 2024. We will contact each applicant individually at their registered email address regardless of whether or not their proposal was accepted.
12	Can I find out about the screening details for my proposal?	We are unable to respond to inquiries regarding screening details, results, or objections regarding the screening process.
13	Is an English or other language interpreter essential? If so, do we need to arrange the interpreter ourselves?	Please see the Japan Association for the 2025 World Exposition Multilingual-related Measures Guidelines regarding multilingual support for events. Arrangements and fees related to multilingual support are to be borne by the parties involved in implementing projects.

14	I want to know all the fees paid to the organiser of the World Expo 2025 to implement a project, prices, and payment timing.	Facility usage fees, utility fees, insurance, and other fees are required. We will contact you regarding information on payment timing after applying.
15	Will facility usage fees, etc. be refunded if I applied for an outdoor facility and the event is canceled due to weather? Will an alternative date be set?	No alternative dates will be set. We are currently in the process of creating regulations regarding the handling of facility usage fees. We will release the answer to this question at a later date.
16	Can we collect admission fees from visitors?	Individual event admission fees cannot be collected from general visitors.
17	How and when will hearings be held?	After entering, a hearing may be held by phone or email by the organiser of the World Expo 2025 and the Office for Events organized by the general public Applications (tentative name) by March 2024
18	How will information sessions be held? What will information sessions cover?	We plan to hold information sessions online (to be archived for offline viewing). Detailed information on implementation will be presented during the sessions, including the schedule for implementation for participants who have received an offer, facility information, and guidelines. -> We plan to hold information sessions online.
