

"TEAM EXPO 2025" Programme FAQs

No.	Question	Answer
1	How can I participate?	There are two ways to participate: Co-Creation Challenges and Co-Creation Partners. Applications to register Co-Creation Challenges and Co-Creation Partners closed on 13 October, 2025, the closing day of the Expo.
2	What is a Co-Creation Challenge?	A "Co-Creation Challenge" refers to activities in which participants take the lead in co-creating towards the future to realise the Expo's theme.
3	What is a Co-Creation Partner?	A "Co-Creation Partner" is a corporation or organisation that supports the Co-Creation Challenge of others by providing the necessary resources, or supports the activities of others to create a Co-Creation Challenge, in order to realise the theme of the Expo.
4	What is the difference between a Co-Creation Challenge and a Co-Creation Partner?	"Co-Creation Challenge" refers to activities carried out primarily by individuals or organisations, and "Co-Creation Partner" refers to corporations and organisations that create and support Co-Creation Challenges.
5	Are there any prohibitions for Co-Creation Challenges and Co-Creation Partners?	Activities for commercial purposes or fundraising purposes are prohibited, so please refer to various regulations such as "TEAM EXPO 2025 Programme Official Website Terms of Use" and "TEAM EXPO 2025 Programme/Co-Creation Member Participation Terms" for details. Please check our Terms of Use.(on the TEAM EXPO 2025 programme page)
6	Are there any registration fees for Co-Creation Challenges and Co-Creation Partners?	There are no registration fees, membership fees, or annual fees.
7	Will you cover the cost of Co-Creation Challenges and Co-Creation Partner activities?	The expenses necessary for the activity must be borne by the participant.
8	How should the programme name, "'TEAM EXPO 2025" programme,' be written?	"TEAM EXPO 2025" is written in all capital letters, and programme is written with a lowercase "p" when used in a sentence but capitalised when used in titles and headers.
9	Why does the programme name have to be written in a specific way?	The "TEAM EXPO 2025" programme has been registered as a trademark, so we have specified the notation.
10	Is there an abbreviation for "'TEAM EXPO 2025" programme'?	The abbreviated version is "TEAM EXPO 2025", but the full name of the programme must be used before abbreviating.
11	How should "'TEAM EXPO 2025" programme' be pronounced?	It is pronounced as "Team Expo Twenty Twenty-Five."
12	How can I inform people about after-Expo events?	You can post your event to the Expo 2025 Osaka, Kansai, Japan Event Information Site (https://feature.peatix.com/expo2025/en) until the end of March 2026.
13	How can I publish my event on the Expo 2025 Osaka, Kansai, Japan event information website?	Please check the procedure described in the "How to List Your Event on This Website" section on the Expo 2025 Osaka, Kansai, Japan Event Information Site (https://feature.peatix.com/expo2025/en) .
14	Until when can we use the "TEAM EXPO 2025" logo?	The "TEAM EXPO 2025" name and logo can be used until Wednesday, 9 April 2031. Application for logo use will be accepted until Friday, 26 December 2025. After that date, logo data submissions and new usage applications will no longer be accepted. When using the logo, please comply with the "TEAM EXPO 2025" Programme Logo Mark Guidelines (on the TEAM EXPO 2025 programme page) and use the logo responsibly.
15	Until when can we use the names "Co-creation Challenge" and "Co-creation Partner"?	There is no issue with using the terms "Co-Creation Challenge" and "Co-Creation Partners" in reports on past participation results, as long as the use falls within normal scope of use. In addition, the logo can be used until 9 April, 2031, the expiration date of the trademark registration.
