

# Visiting the Expo Site by Station Shuttle Bus


- Visitors to the Expo site are advised to use public transport (trains, station shuttle buses, etc.).
- Station shuttle buses run directly to the Expo site from 10 major railway station bus terminals. (A fare will be charged for the ride.)
- All station shuttle buses require advance booking, except for buses to and from Sakurajima Station. This is a comfortable way to travel to the Expo site while seated (\*1). There is also a special service that links the railways and station shuttle buses, so please take advantage of this service.
- Shuttle buses operating from Sakurajima Station will be electric buses, normally running on five-minute intervals between 8:00 and 10:00, during peak visitor hours. During this time, priority will be given to those who have paid in advance. There are also pre-booked slots available throughout the day for wheelchair and pushchair (stroller) users.



\* 1 Excludes some services to/from Osaka Station (South: Maru Bldg.), Nakanoshima Station, and Sakurajima Station Shuttle Buses.

\* 2 Osaka Station has two locations: North= Umekita and South= Maru Bldg.

\* 3 The Bentencho Station Bus Terminal is used temporarily in the event of transport disruptions, etc., so there are no regular services.

Access from Kintetsu Osaka-Uehommachi Station From the underground platform (Nara Line, B2F), proceed to the ground level; from the above-ground platform (Osaka Line, aboveground), proceed directly to the bus terminal ticket gate\* (aboveground).

Go out the bus terminal ticket gate, turn right down the passage, and take the escalator or elevator to the Kintetsu Uehonmachi Bus Terminal on the 2nd floor. (about 5 to 10 minutes on foot)










Tea Ceremony Experience (Sakai Plaza of Rikyu and Akiko)



### •A Short walk from Hanshin and JR Amagasaki Stations.

There are two shuttle bus stops: one at Hanshin Amagasaki Station (left from the West Ticket Gate on the south side) and one at JR Amagasaki Station (on the south side of the station).

Both stations are connected to the bus stops by a roof, so you can transfer without getting wet even if it rains!

### •Advance reservations allow passengers to sit comfortably on their way to the Expo site.

(Nearby Stations: Mikage Station, Uozaki Station, Nishinomiya Station, Nada Gogo is a sake-producing region that boasts the largest volume of sake production in the world. In addition to the sake brewing museum and memorial hall, there are also sake breweries with restaurants where visitors can enjoy both sake and food.

### 2 Mt. Rokko

(Reachable via: Kobe City Bus from Mikage Station, Rokko Cable Car) A short distance from the Hanshin area, you can enjoy the naturale beauty of Mt. Rokko

Take the Rokko Cable Car or Rokko Sanjo Bus to visit sightseeing facilities and museums on the mountain.

Of course, the "Million Dollar Nightscape" is not to be missed.

#### 3 Hyogo Prefectural Museum of Art (Nearest Station: Iwaya Station)

As the prefectural base of the Expo, a special exhibition (admission free) will be held where visitors can enjoy and learn about Hyogo's efforts, including a three-dimensional puzzle of Tajima beef. Visitors can also enjoy the digital artwork of "Mirai no Hyogo" (Future Hyogo) drawn by children in the prefecture, which will be exhibited as one city. [Early April - 13 October, 2025].

### (3) Use rental bicycles for sightseeing along the Hanshin Railway!

Using a rental bicycle is a more convenient and comfortable way of traveling from the station.


